Continuing the Legacy of Jim McEntee:

The Jim McEntee Memorial Scholarship Awards were initiated in 2007 to assist community college students in need transferring to a four-year college or university to complete their undergraduate studies. Since that time, under the leadership of the Friends of Human Relations (FHR)/ Jim McEntee Legacy Committee, \$168,500. has been awarded to sixty-one students.

FHR now offers two years of funding to every eligible student scholarship recipient. The Friends Board is also committed to support and track all scholarship recipients until they graduate from a four year college or university.


