

Jim McEntee Scholarship Application For the 2025-2026 Academic Year

Eligibility for the Jim McEntee Legacy Scholarship:

This scholarship fund is open solely to community college students in Santa Clara County who are transferring this academic year to a four-year university with junior year status. Students are encouraged to apply who have overcome obstacles to obtain a college education, including but not limited to: racial, religious, minority and/ or immigrant status, LGBTQ, disability, foster child, and/ or poverty. By submitting this application, you agree to receive mentorship by our organization (if selected) until you graduate. Most first year recipients are eligible for a second-year scholarship if enrollment is current, and the recipient has been in regular contact with their scholarship mentor. Applications are confidential and will be accepted during the months of February, March, and April 2025. *Applications must be received by 11:59 pm on May 11, 2025.* Recipients will be notified no later than June 15, 2025.

Instructions: Complete and print the following application. Be sure to sign the form.

Obtain at least two reference letters. One must be from an organization where you have done volunteer work. The other must be from a representative at your current school, such as a counselor, professor, etc.

Obtain an official transcript from your present college and from all others previously attended. We do not accept unofficial transcripts.

Write a personal essay (not more than 750 words) describing yourself, your family experience, your community involvement, volunteer work you have done, your educational and professional goals, and how these goals relate to a vision for a better world. Why do you meet the qualifications of this scholarship? Mail/ Drop off your application, reference letters, college acceptance letter/s, and personal essay to the following address:
